

DOMAINE J. CHAMONARD FLEURIE – 'LA MADONE'

VINIFICATION

The grapes are from old vines (60–90 years old) with granite soils and average altitudes of 400m, located in the "La Madone" plot in Villié–Morgon, Beaujolais, France. The harvest is manual and the grapes are destemmed and gently pressed. The must ferments in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperatures and the wine is aged for 10 months in French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Appearance: Ruby with garnet reflections.
Nose: Intense and complex, with aromas of fresh red fruits, violets, spices and toast.
Palate: Full-bodied and soft, with smooth tannins and a long and persistent finish.

Pairing Suggestions:

White meat, such as chicken, rabbit and pork.
Fresh water fish.
Light and flavorful dishes.
