Acidity: Medium-plus

Tannins: Medium-plus

Body: Medium-full

Finish: Long and lingering

The wine has a full-bodied flavor with a velvety texture. The acidity is medium-plus, which helps to balance the fruitiness of the wine. The tannins are medium-plus, which give the wine structure and length. The finish is long and lingering.
