Backgroun d

In Rosé by nature we try to reveal the quintessence of early pressed red grapes. Only biodynamically cultivated grapes are used, primarily Blaufränkisch. The goal is to undermine preconceived taste images and to unite the voices of terroir, vintage and grape variety and to translate them consistently and uncompromisingly into wine. Ergo: no technical sophistication, dramaturgical predictability, illusions and special effects, but craftsmanship in the vineyard as well as in the cellar, spontaneous fermentation, long yeast contact and authenticity. And no temperature control, no filters and no SO. Beyond our personal handwriting, the vintage naturally plays a decisive role (or is it actually more accurate to say that we adapt the handwriting to the vintage). This was rather mixed until late summer, before a record-breaking period of good weather ensured ideal conditions and absolutely perfect grape material.

Style & flavour

Expressive and animating. A rosé that has a lot to tell. For example, that Blaufränkisch works in many different ways. Or that light-heartedness and depth can be two sides of the same coin. And last but not least, that Rosé, completely free of kitsch and without residual sugar, is an alternative that should be chosen much more often. Aromatically, our ROSÉ BY NATURE comes up with wild raspberries, tamarind, blood oranges and floral notes. It is stringent and clear, has focus and combines energy and vitality with a lot of substance. The finish is punchy, straightforward and red-fruited.
